Payment: All payments are online. All sessions can be paid in monthly installments. A \$58.65 Skate Canada fee will be applied to all BSC home club skaters. Non-BSC home club skaters will have this fee deleted and refunded during invoice review by our administrator

Skate Up/Down Requests: Skater up/down requests must come from coaches

Dressing Rooms/Warm-up Area: ONLY skaters and coaches are permitted to enter dressing rooms and/or view sessions from the dressing room hallways. This is a safe sport factor in addition to ensuring enough space for skaters to properly warm-up

Buy-ins: If there is space, a skater may 'buy-in' on a session. Skaters must confirm with their coach prior to purchasing the space

Off-Ice: Off-ice is a key component of a skater's development. It helps ensure skater safety and better use of on-ice time. Please speak to your coach if you need to miss an off-ice session

Additional sessions: BSC is proud to collaborate with Halifax Skating Club to offer additional sessions in a co-ordinated schedule to maximize ice time. Please check their brochure and speak to your coach about these sessions

CanSkate Program Assistants: CanSkate PAs are required for our Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday classes. PA Training will be on Thursday, Sept.28. Details to follow

Skater & Parent behaviour: All participants of BSC sessions must adhere to the Skate Canada Code of Ethics. Skaters and/or parents documented to be bullying (in-person and/or on social media), using inappropriate language, exhibiting inappropriate dressing room behaviours (i.e. taking pictures of other skaters, talking down to other skaters, leaving garbage on the benches and/or floor, displays of romantic relationships, etc.) and/or any other dangerous and/or disrespectful behaviour towards other skaters, parents and/or coaches will be addressed by coaches and/or BSC Board of Directors. Pending the severity of the behaviour(s), skaters and/or parents may be removed from the club
