ALL NEW SKATE CANADA MEMBERS START IN PRECANSKATE. New skaters are tested on day 1 and moved to a higher level group if appropriate. Skaters must be 4+ years old as of Oct.1 the year of registration.

Payment: All payment must be made online. All sessions can be paid in 2 installments by selecting the option when completing registration. All registrations will include a \$58.65 Skate Canada fee that will be added to registration when checking out.

Dressing Rooms/Warm-up Area: Please limit dressing rooms to the skater and 1 caregiver as the rooms are very small. **CanSkaters are strongly encouraged to arrive ice ready with their skates on.**

PRECANSKATE/CANSKATE

PreCanSkate - no Skate Canada program experience CanSkate - Stage 1+ from a Skate Canada program

Skaters registered for a program they don't qualify for WILL have their registration canceled with registering for the correct program or waitlist being the responsibility of the parent. Please do not try to "skip the line" by registering for a program showing space if your skater doesn't qualify for it.

CanSkate is a learn-to-skate program for skaters who are 4+ years old as of Oct.1 the year of registration **or** have done the BSC Spring PreSchool session. Skaters are grouped by age and level with a maximum of 10 skaters per group. Groups are led by trained program assistants and coached by Skate Canada Professional Coaches. Instruction is in a group format (one-on-one lessons are not available at this level). **Registered skaters must wear a certified hockey helmet. Cages are highly recommended for beginner to Stage 3 skaters. Hockey or figure skates are permitted.**
