RETURNING MEMBER REGISTRATION: Wednesday, Aug.13 @ 7pm

Returning member: A skater (or sibling of) who was registered for a BSC session during Fall/Winter 2024-2025 and/or Spring 2025 & have the returning member registration code

WAITLIST MEMBER REGISTRATION: Friday, Aug.15 @ 7pm

Waitlist members: Any skater on the Fall/Winter 2024-2025 and/or Spring 2025 waitlist & have the waitlist member registration code

NEW MEMBER REGISTRATION: Monday, Aug.18 @ 10am

New members: Any skater not registered with BSC for the Fall/Winter 2024-2025 and/or Spring 2025 season and not on the waitlist for either of those. Skaters switching from a different club and who are not on a BSC waitlist are considered new members as they are new to BSC.

REGISTRATION CODES: Registration codes are needed for RETURNING & WAITLIST members to register. These codes will be emailed to these groups prior to their registration windows

NEW MEMBERS!

All new skaters start at the PreCanSkate level of CanSkate. Skaters are tested on day 1 and moved to a higher level group if appropriate. Skaters must be 4+ years old as of Oct.1 the year of registration

CanSkate Groupings: Groups are based on age and level and are checked on day 1 with adjustments as needed. Group colours do not correspond to a specific level and are fluid through the season as skaters complete ribbons and badges - i.e. a skater may not switch groups by passing a ribbon or badge if they still match the level of all other skaters in their current group.

CanSkate sessions are group format and NOT one-on-one. If your skater has an adaptation that requires one-on-one attention please email Becky at bedfordskatingclub@hotmail.com BEFORE registering.

Levels: CanSkate is made up of PreCanSkate and Stage 1-6. Stage 1-6 is broken down into Agility, Balance, and Control. No experience is required for new skaters.

PreAcademy 1 & 2: Invite only program. Skaters receive a direct invite for this program after being identified using the club Skater Identification Matrix.

Payment: All payment must be made online. All sessions can be paid in 2 installments by selecting the option when completing registration - the first due at registration and the second Dec.1

All new member registrations will include a \$61.65 Skate Canada fee that will be added to registration when checking out.

Dressing rooms: Dressing rooms will be available but space is **very** limited. **Only use your assigned dressing room!** Skaters are encouraged to arrive ice ready.

Report cards: Report cards will be posted to your BSC account at the end of December and within 2 weeks of the end of the season.

Volunteers needed: Volunteers are the key to our success. Each CanSkate session needs 2-3 "Rink Parents" to run efficiently. This is an off-ice position during the CanSkate session only. CANSKATE

CanSkate - PreCanSkate-Stage 6

Registration codes are required for RETURNING and WAITLIST members. Codes will be sent by email prior to those group's registration windows. New members will not need a code.

CanSkate is a learn-to-skate program. Skaters are grouped by age and level with a maximum of 10 skaters per group. Groups are led by trained program assistants and coached by Skate Canada Professional Coaches. Instruction is in a group format (one-on-one lessons are not available at this level).

Skaters must be 4 as of Oct.1 the year of registration and no older than 16 as of Oct.1 the year of registration.

"A CSA approved helmet must be worn by skaters up to, and including, Stage 5 of the CanSkate program. Any exception to the use of a CSA approved helmet must be provided by Skate Canada in writing. All participants in a sledge must wear a helmet. Use of a Bold Helmet requires written approval from Skate Canada."

Bike and ski helmets are NOT permitted! Skaters will not be permitted on the ice with these helmets

Face masks are required for beginner to Stage 3 skaters.

All skaters regardless of level must wear a helmet on the BSC CanSkate session.

Hockey or figure skates are permitted.

Skaters must be Stage 3-5 or have approval. Skaters will be introduced to figure skating moves while continuing to develop their basic skating skills. Off-ice is also introduced. "A CSA approved helmet must be worn by skaters up to, and including, Stage 5 of the CanSkate program. Any exception to the use of a CSA approved helmet must be provided by Skate Canada in writing. All participants in a sledge must wear a helmet. Use of a Bold Helmet requires written approval from Skate Canada."
